Growing Closer to God and to One Another Through Sunday Worship and Beyond at Redeeming Grace

Why and How:

- A continued desire for more of God's voice in our worship services.
 - More scripture each week
 - Encountering more of the whole counsel of God in our worship services.
- A greater unity and commonality in our worship services.
 - Giving everyone the ability to come together on Sunday mornings prepared for worship.
 - Having a common tool for individual, family, small group, and one on one discipleship.
- A deeper and wider congregational participation in our worship services.
 - Sundays should be filled with movement!
 - o Each believer is a member of the worship team.
 - This gives an opportunity for more participation in the leading of worship each week. (Sign up to be a reader!)
- Seeing Sunday mornings as a catalyst for devotion, relationship building, and ministry.
 - o A Common Love (Drawing near to God and to one another).
 - A Common Faith (Holding fast to our confession, together).
 - A Common Mission (Stirring one another up to love and good works).

What to Do:

- 1. *Do the work!* We need to believe that the more prepared we are to worship together, the more Christ-exalting and believer-encouraging our worship services will be.
- Believe that each member matters! Don't forsake the importance of gathering together
 for worship and don't forget that what each of us brings to the table on Sunday mornings
 matters.
- 3. *Don't let it stop on Sunday!* Take everything we've received on Sunday and put it into practice and conversation in our homes, places of work, schools, etc.
